• [month, 2 digits][day, 2 digits][year, 2 digits][your first name-last name initials].JPG Example: Web Master scans in a color chip and creates a file on January 5th, 2000. File is saved as **010500WM.JPG** Note, if you have multiple color samples you can included them in one common file. Please include your name, email and telephone number in case we have additional questions.
