

The B.A.R.E. was started and always has been managed by "rails" who really worked on the railroads. We don't have to "bluff" about being railroad men.


We are a railroad man's organization from start to finish. When you join with us you find yourself among real friends. And you don't have to be very smart to know that you will get better treatment and more for your money.
